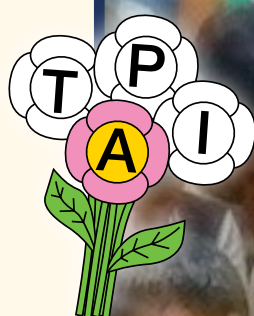

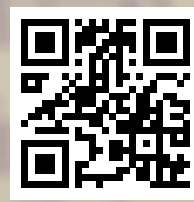
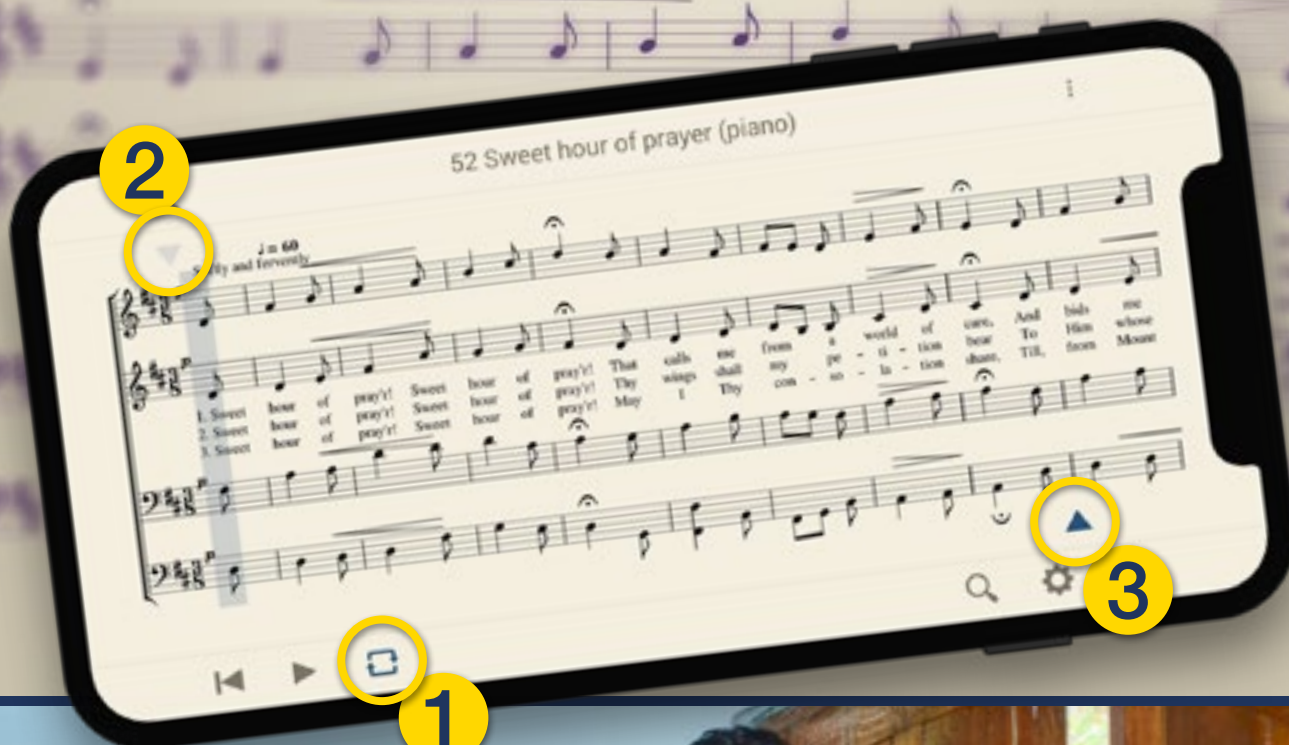

HOW TO LOOP SONGS IN MUESCORE:

- 1) Tap the loop button on the bottom left
- 2) Long press where the loop should start: A blue triangle will show up on top.
- 3) Long press where the loop should end: A blue triangle will show up on the bottom.

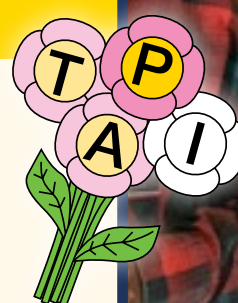

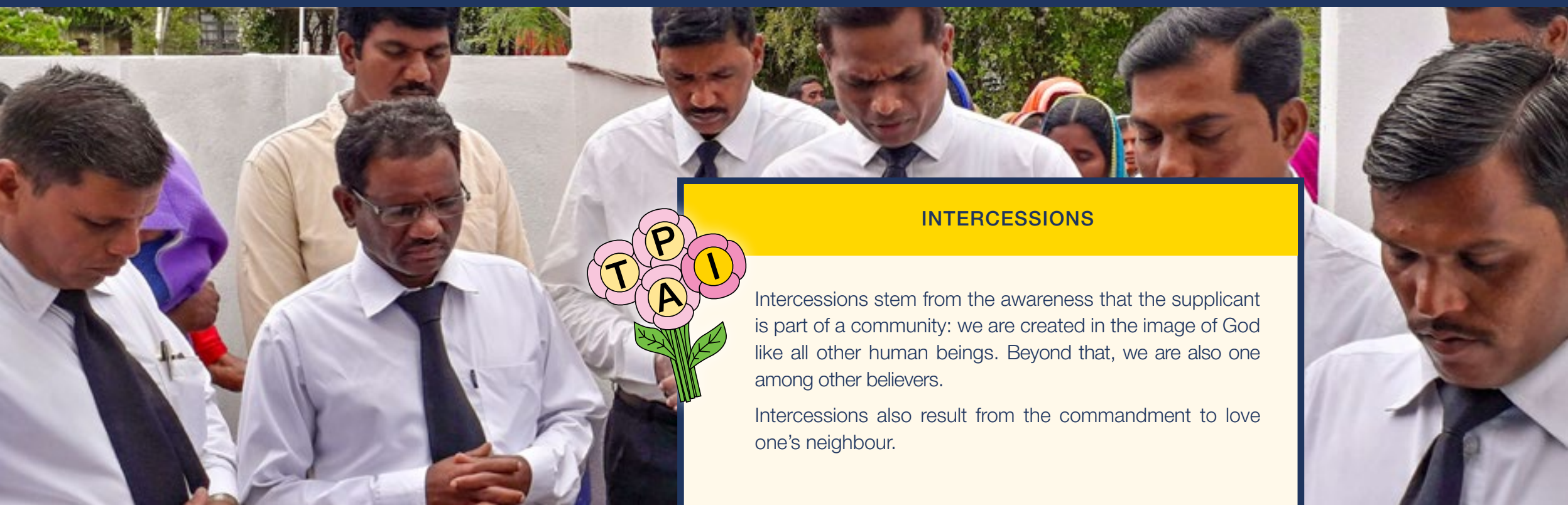

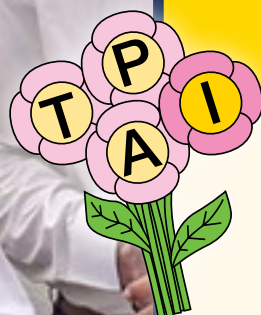
